



Reduced rate

- 2 days a week: 5%
- 4 days a week: 10%

Cancellation Fees

- Two or more weeks before the first assignment, only the administrative tax will be charged (CHF 100).
- Less than 2 weeks before the first assignment, the administrative tax (CHF 100) and the pre-paid amount for 2 weeks daycare will be charged.

Baby-sitting

An evening or a week-end out: Le Chaperon Rouge recommends that you use its baby-sitter network. The guardians are at least 16 years old. They are selected and trained by the Geneva Red Cross. A free list is available but only for the members of our association.

Break or Breather Voucher

Le Chaperon Rouge also offers families needing a few hours of relief some "Breather Vouchers" (bons de respiration). When help can't be found with relatives or friends, this gives parents some free time while their children are being taken care of by reliable people.

You can get the vouchers from Red Cross Partners (pediatricians, health and social workers, several associations). The voucher is a fixed price of CHF 6 for 3.30 hours. Each parent or family, with a child from 0 up to 4, can get up to 3 vouchers per year.

CHILD DAYCARE AT HOME

Le Chaperon Rouge (Red Riding Hood) was founded in 1993 by 'La Croix-Rouge genevoise' (The Geneva Red Cross), as a Home Daycare Service. This aid is given to parents of children from 0 to 12 years old in the Canton of Geneva.



Le Chaperon Rouge was originally set up to provide urgent help at home for parents who had a child or children that suddenly became ill. More recently, Le Chaperon Rouge has adapted its support for more individual needs.

Today, parents who need to fulfill some commitments outside of their home and who are unable to find any other care solution (close relatives, nursery, nanny) can request a Chaperon Rouge Caretaker to come to their home. This covers ill or healthy children.

Who are the Chaperon Rouge Caretakers?

The Caretakers are trained and their skills guaranteed by the Croix-Rouge genevoise. Their work is done in accordance with the Fundamental Principles and Values of the Red Cross.

Le Chaperon Rouge works in partnership with Geneva's Service des Emplois de Solidarité (SEdS) de l'Office cantonal de l'emploi (OCE)¹.

Urgent Help - from 2 hours up to 3 days

Your child is ill, your usual child care is unavailable, you must leave your home unexpectedly?

A simple call and the "Chaperon Rouge" will provide you with daycare support within 4 hours. Priority is given to parents with an ill child (benign illnesses). Requests made by email are not taken accepted.

The Caretakers will come to your place 6 days a week, from 7am to 9pm for a minimum of 2 hours.

In order to obtain a reduced rate, you need to send the certificate verifying your health insurance subsidy to Le Chaperon Rouge.

First by phone. Written confirmation of your demand including the certificate delivered by your child's health insurance policy along with the following documents: the unified determining income certificate (RDU for "revenu déterminant unifié"), the child's health insurance policy and the family's civil liability insurance policy.

Rates

Rates are based on your determining income (RDU) delivered by the tax authorities. To determine the cost, the income of all the people included in a common household is taken into account. The total charge will also include an administrative tax of CHF 100 (CHF 30 the following years) and transport expenses of CHF 6 per day or CHF 70 per month, based on Geneva Public Transportation fares (TPG).

Deposit: the administrative tax and the cost of two weeks daycare must be paid at least ten days before the first assignment.
