

Early childhood and the Early Childhood Service (SDPE) in the City of Geneva

- Early childhood day-care structures:
 - Private legal facilities
 - Some of them are subsidised by the City of Geneva
 - 4 months and 4 years (until primary school)
- Organised in the form of an association or foundation caring for children aged between
- Mission of the Early Childhood Service:
 - Development and implementation of institutional and pedagogical projects
 - Administrative and financial management
 - Human resources management
 - Compliance with data protection
 - Ethical reflection



City of Geneva

- Halte-jeux:
 - Occasional child day-care solution for a few hours only. Without registration.
- Espaces enfants-parents:
 - Place for children and parents/caregivers (for parental support and playground). Without registration.

 - Day trips outdoors all year round, minimum 4 days, maximum 4 days, departure and return at Cornavin train station

Early childhood information bureau (BIPE)

- Specifications
- Registration from the twelfth week of pregnancy
- Registrations must be renewed every six months (not automatic)
- Applications are handled on a first-come, first-served basis
- No guaranteed places. Other possibilities:
 - Approved child minders (list available from the BIPE)
 - Approved parental assistants “Mary Poppins” (list available at <https://www.022familles.ch/famille/garde-enfants/>)
 - Emergency childcare : Chaperon rouge (<https://www.croix-rouge-ge.ch/>)

Place allocation and priority criteria

- Resident or working in the City of Geneva
- Both parents working (employment, training, unemployment or job-seeking registered with the ORP)
- Openning date of the application

Place allocation and priority criteria

- **5 priority criteria**
- Concerning social situations
- Siblings
- Single-parent families
- Children of educational staff on permanent contracts
- Change of daycare following a move

- If a family moves outside the city limits during the course of the year, the children cannot retain their spot after the end of the school year.
- “Ô comme 3 pommes” (52 places) primarily welcomes the children of staff of IOs, NGOs and diplomatic representations

Annual Fees

- Calculation of fees adapted to the financial capacity of the users according to a [price chart](#) available online:
 - Minimum price of CHF 1,163 for a relevant income of CHF 16,000 or less*
 - Maximum price of CHF 25,120 for a relevant income of CHF 220,000 and more*
- For siblings:
 - Half-price for the second child
 - Free for the third child

Bubbles Crèches is a network of private nurseries in French-speaking Switzerland, founded by the Lavorel Kids & Education Group and Bubbles Kids Club, two well-known actors in the Early Childhood sector. In a playful and caring environment, we welcome preschool-aged children in facilities offering extended services (open at least 45 hours per week, providing lunch, and operating at least 45 weeks per year).

Educational supervision is provided by staff whose qualifications and skills meet the requirements of the SASAJ (Service for the Authorization and Supervision of Daycare Services).


LAVOREL KIDS & EDUCATION

New requirements regarding residency

- **To be eligible for the Geneva public school system, new requirements have come into effect for the 2026-27 school year.**
- **The pupil and at least one parent must reside in the canton of Geneva.**
- **To prove residency, a set of documents must be provided.**
- **A parent's employment at an international institution no longer entitles pupils residing outside the canton to admission to the Geneva public school system.**

New requirements regarding residency

Residence in the canton of Geneva	Pupils can be enrolled in the Geneva public education system.
Residence in France	<p>Primary school and Orientation cycle : Pupils cannot be enrolled in the Geneva public education system; They must be enrolled in France ; They can however be enrolled in a private school in Geneva.</p> <p>Upper secondary : Students cannot be enrolled in a general or vocational training at school (full-time). They must find an apprenticeship position with an employer in Geneva.</p>
Residence in another Swiss canton	<p>Primary school and Orientation cycle : Pupils cannot be enrolled in the Geneva public education system ; They must be enrolled in their canton of residence (except for those whose canton of residence covers the costs as per intercantonal agreements) ; They can be enrolled in a private school in Geneva.</p> <p>Upper secondary : Students can be enrolled in a general or vocational training at school (full-time) if their canton of residence agrees to finance their schooling and issues a certificate. They can also find an apprenticeship position with an employer in Geneva or be enrolled in a private school in Geneva.</p>

How can I get the school supplies ?

- Manuals and school supplies are provided for free by the school staff
- Provided by the family : sports outfits and shoes, slippers, "basane" (ballerinas), gymnastic slippers in lower grades



- **Orientation cycle**

- Manuals and school supplies are provided for free by the school staff
- Provided by the family : sports outfits and shoes, backpack and pen case

- **Upper secondary school**

- Manuals and school supplies are to be bought by the family, according to teacher's instructions

Welcoming non French speaking pupils in Geneva's educational system (Welcome classes)

Primary school Welcome classes

- **Pupils grade 1P-3P** : 100% regular class, with individual support if needed
- **Pupils grade 4P-8P** : 50% in regular class, 50% in welcome class for 12 months, essentially dedicated to French language
- No formalized assessment for max 24 months after arrival

Orientation cycle Welcome classes

- Schooling : 100% in a Welcome class
- 10/33 periods (45 minutes) dedicated to French courses
- 3/33 periods dedicated to mother language courses, if available
- Progressive integration into regular class

Upper secondary school Welcome classes

- Schooling : 100% in welcome class for 1 year. Can be extended in some cases. Then, transition class for 1 year to prepare access to academic or professional training
- 11 periods dedicated to French courses
- 2 periods dedicated to mother language courses, if available
- 12 facilities in Geneva







Nearly 1 in 5 students attend one of Geneva's 70 private schools

AGEP: a guarantee of quality

- AGEP: Geneva Association of Private Schools, founded in 1959
- 45 schools and institutions, adhering to quality certification procedures and a code of conduct
- From nursery to higher education, including language, hotel and business schools
- A variety of pedagogical approaches, including:
 - Montessori
 - Pédagogie active
 - International education
 - National curricula (France, Germany, UK, Switzerland)
- Programmes taught in French, English, German or bilingually
- Children permitted to join a private school if they will be 3 years old by December 31st (2 years 8 months) - vs. 4 years old to join a public school

Thinking about a private school?

First things to think about...

- Your child's age and previous educational background
- Your family situation, including languages spoken at home
- Your professional context (How long will you be in Geneva? Will you be moving soon? Where will you likely move next?)
- Your budget

...then identify the key elements that are important to you in choosing a school

- A curriculum based on a particular educational philosophy / methodology
- Where your child is likely to study after completing their compulsory education
- Whether you want your child to follow a national or international system
- Whether certain areas of study are more or less important
- Which languages you/your child speaks or wants to speak
- Support structures (e.g. for special educational needs, language acquisition skills)
- Availability and range of Extra-curricular activities, including childcare outside of regular school hours

Finding the right school

- Visit the AGEP website, where you will find all our member schools: www.agep.ch
- Take advice from friends, colleagues, your/your partner's HR team or relocation contacts
- Visit the schools' websites and social media pages to get a feel for the school culture
- A few things to bear in mind:
 - Does the school have a clear mission and educational philosophy - and does it align with your beliefs?
 - Does the school have strong academic results?
 - Does the organisation of the school day (and provision of outside of hours childcare) align with your needs?
 - Is the school's location convenient for your home or workplace (bearing in mind Geneva traffic!)
- Select the schools which are the best match for your child
- Contact the schools to arrange a visit and meet the admissions team

Areas to probe during your visit

Academic

- Questions about the curriculum (place of languages, technology, arts, sports...) and academic results
- Is there a university guidance/counselling service?
- Where do students go after graduating? (What % go to higher education, to which universities?)
- What services/resources are in place to support children with additional needs?

Practical

- How is the school structured? Who would be your contact person?
- How is pastoral care organised?
- How are parents involved in the life of the school?
- What is the discipline policy?
- What costs are involved beyond the tuition fees? (Cafeteria, transport, trips, compulsory equipment...)
- What are the admissions criteria and procedure?

Final considerations

- It's always better to visit a school during school hours
- Make sure your child visits the school and sees a classroom in action if you can
- Try to speak to staff who will be working with your child, not just the admissions team


