

- **ASK Bilingual Camp** is an inclusive program for children and teenagers aged **3–16** with Learning Differences and Special Educational Needs, offering a safe and supportive environment.
- The fully integrated program helps participants develop **social skills, creativity, and learning** through fun, age-appropriate activities tailored to individual skill levels.
- The camp is led by a **highly qualified multidisciplinary team**, including psychologists, specialist drama/theatre teachers, counselors, speech therapists, ABA therapists, art and music therapists, and sports coaches.
