



International Geneva Welcome Centre

Founded in 1996 by the Swiss Confederation and the Canton of Geneva, the International Geneva Welcome Centre (CAGI) is funded by national, local, public and private entities. Its mission is to facilitate the settling-in and integration to Geneva and the Lake Lemman region, of all international civil servants, members of Permanent Missions, consulates, NGOs, multinational companies, PhD students and professors at Hôpitaux Universitaires de Genève and at the University of Geneva, along with their families. Besides practical assistance, it organises and supports cultural and social events, enabling exchanges between the Geneva International and local communities.

Services offered by the CAGI


- **Welcome Programme** : for international newcomers to facilitate their integration and help them discover Geneva's multicultural aspects and traditions. This programme is coordinated by CAGI and run by the Newcomer Network of the Fondation pour Genève, a group of Geneva-based volunteers who help the CAGI in its mission of welcoming and promoting relations between Geneva's international community and the local population.



- **Practical Geneva** : support in accommodation search, lease proof-reading, administrative procedures, litigation, insurance, education, health and mobility.

- **Cultural Kiosk at UN Geneva and CERN** : information on the cultural and tourist offerings of the region, ticket sales.
- **Assistance to NGOs** already based in Geneva, as well as those interested in setting up an office in the region, and facilitation of the stays of delegations (governmental or NGOs) participating in conferences organised by the actors of the International Geneva.



Welcome call

Based on the lists sent monthly by the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA), a welcome letter is addressed to those arriving during the month, informing them of the services offered by the CAGI, and specifically the programme of the Newcomer Network. These newcomers are then contacted by telephone by our volunteers.

These welcome calls are greatly appreciated and give a personal touch which can in many cases bring immediate help or a rapid response to practical questions, faced by all newcomers.

Lunchtime conferences

All International newcomers to Geneva are invited to lunchtime conferences held throughout the year. These conferences provide newcomers with the opportunity to learn about practical, social and cultural aspects of life in the city.



A minimum intermediate level of language proficiency is required.
