- The Humanitarian Hub is a 1300m² coworking space in [Geneva](#) that hosts 16 NGOs
- A space designed to foster collaboration and innovation among humanitarian actors in International Geneva

CHS Alliance promotes respect for the rights and dignity of people and communities vulnerable to risk and affected by disaster, conflict or poverty and enhance the effectiveness and impact of assistance by building a culture of quality and accountability



DRC works in conflict-affected areas, along displacement routes, and in the countries where refugees settle. Its work includes everything from relief operations to strengthening opportunities for a brighter future for refugees and internally displaced persons



IDMC provides high-quality data, analysis and expertise on internal displacement with the aim of informing policy and operational decisions that can reduce the risk of future displacement and improve the lives of internally displaced people worldwide



International Council of Voluntary Agencies (ICVA) is a global NGO network advocating for principled and effective humanitarian action



NRC safeguards the rights of displaced people during crises through targeted interventions in six key areas: food security, education, shelter, legal aid, protection from violence, and water, sanitation, and hygiene
