The CAGI was founded in 1996; its mission is to facilitate the settling-in and integration to Geneva and the Lake Leman region of all international employees along with their families:

- · civil servants,
- · members of Permanent Missions.
- · consulates,
- · NGOs.
- · multinational companies,
- PhD students and professors at Hôpitaux Universitaires de Genève and at the University of Geneva

Besides practical assistance, it organises and supports cultural and social events, enabling exchange between the Geneva International and local communities.

### Services offered by the CAGI for International Geneva's newcomers

• The Welcome Programme: offers a series of activities designed to facilitate the integration of international newcomers to Geneva. These activities are intended to provide insight into the city's multicultural aspects and traditions. The programme is coordinated by CAGI and run by the Newcomer Network of the Fondation pour Genève. The Newcomer Network is a group of Geneva-based volunteers who assist CAGI in its mission of welcoming and promoting relations between Geneva's international community and the local population.



- Housing support: accommodation search, lease proofreading, administrative procedures, litigation support, insurance.
- The practical guide for newcomers: essential information on settling and integrating internationals and their families in Geneva.
- Cultural Kiosks at UN Geneva and CERN: provide information on the cultural and tourist
  offerings of the region, as well as ticket sales.



## **WELCOME CALL**

In accordance with the lists issued on a monthly basis by the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA), an invitation to the forthcoming « Welcome Coffee» is extended to the month's newcomers. Subsequently, newcomers are contacted by telephone by the volunteers responsible for the programme.

The welcome calls are highly valued and provide a personalised service, which can often facilitate prompt assistance or a rapid response to the practical queries commonly faced by newcomers.


