

# The voice of Swiss grant-making foundations


- SwissFoundations was founded in Basel in 2001 as the joint initiative of eleven
   Swiss grant-making foundations and is today an organisation of grant-making foundations for grant-making foundations.
- Membership is open to grant-making foundations that are based in Switzerland or Liechtenstein, have their own assets and use these or their generated profits for charitable purposes. There are no restrictions regarding areas of support.
- As of March 2024, 224 grant-making foundations are members of SwissFoundations.








# ... often seen as a paradise for foundations



## The number of foundations has almost tripled since 1990




## ZH, VD, BE & GE account for half of all foundations






# Tips & Tricks when dealing with grant-making foundations What you should always consider

- Clearly defined foundation purposes
- A high match between your application and the foundation's purpose increases your chances
- Projects are more likely to be funded than organisations or operating costs
- Many foundations prefer long-term partnerships
- Check the possibility of inviting foundation members to your project
- Check whether the foundation accepts applications at all



# Looking for the best match



#### And now in more detail

 Find grant-making foundations that match your projects on stiftungschweiz.ch



- Then use the websites of the grant-making foundations to check if there are eligibility criteria, exclusion criteria, age limits for applicants?
- Study similarities between the funding foundation and your projects
- If online research does not bring enough results, give them a call
- Observe submission deadlines, sometimes funding is only awarded once a year
- Keep your project schedule flexible, applications are not answered overnight
- Keep the project flexible in case the funder wants to exert influence

#### **Basics**





- Please note the information provided by funding foundations on what is expected for the dossier - content, digital/analogue?
- Good **structure**, **guidance** in the **document**, table of contents, management summary
- Comprehensibility, have texts tested for comprehensibility by non-experts



Elements of the dossier: The introductory letter





- **Personalised and tailored.** Address the funding foundation, write personally.
- Align it with the foundation's funding strategy



Elements of the dossier : Organisation & Project

- Biography of the applicant, statutes of the organisation
- Why are you or your organisation **eligible for funding**, qualifications, expert opinions, evaluations
- Locate project in the organisation's field of activity
- Describe the project in detail and enthusiastically, but get to the point
- **Describe** where and how the project and the funding organisation **do match**
- Target audience, objectives, intended impact, innovative aspects
- Use Al...









- Be precise
- Provide an accurate cost estimate as an overview



- Last annual report, last annual balance sheet to show financial needs
- Income what exactly is it made up of
- Expenses infrastructure? Personnel? Materials? Rent? Public relations?
   Advertising? Project evaluation?
- Other requested support from funding organisations, existing commitments



- Invest in the research
- Customise your applications
- Invest in the relationship with a funding foundation that supports you
- Use modern tools
